Dear \_\_\_\_\_:

I am prosecuting Centre County public officials, and you can help. I come to you, having:

- A) filed a private criminal complaint, executed/sent September 25, 2016, which has yet to be acknowledged by the District Attorney, charging former Centre County Sheriff Denny Nau with misdemeanors in office, and
- B) intended to prosecute District Attorney Stacy Parks Miller for neglect or refusal to do her duty of office, having failed to dis-/approve my complaint, received November 7, 2016, without unreasonable delay.

I am currently falsely imprisoned in Centre County.

I am asking you to put your eyes upon, and your people unto, this task. Review the materials. Contact the offices and the officials. Pass along the story. Report on it if you can. Ask me how *you* can take part in justice.

A warden holds me without warrant of detainer – paperwork – at the Centre County Correctional-Facility/ Prison/Jail near Bellefonte, Pennsylvania, as of August 15, 2016. From this jail, I submitted through jailhouse mailbox via first class mail, an original private criminal complaint charging former Centre County Sheriff Denny Nau with Neglect or Refusal to Perform Duties, 16 P.S. § 411, and Official Oppression, 18 Pa.C.S. § 5301. Denny Nau had failed to provide in writing a statutory reason and good cause under the Uniform Firearms Act, 18 Pa.C.S. § 6109(i), during an April 2008 attempt to revoke my Pa. License to Carry Firearms. This is a crime.

Following 33 days without acknowledgment, approval, or disapproval of the complaint from the District Attorney’s Office, I arranged certified mail that again contained an original signed complaint of the same date. I included a letter to District Attorney Stacy Parks Miller herself, asking *her* to acknowledge the submission of the complaint, and to provide information on the pre-approval complaint inquiry, so that I might know whether the delay was reasonable or unreasonable, under Rule 506 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure. As of December 25, 2016, I had received no response from the District Attorney or her office. I submitted a Right-to-Know Law request to the District Attorney’s office in order to prove I have been heard.

I intend to employ private counsel to conduct prosecution, under the County Code, 16 P.S. § 1409, to seek a finding of guilt for Denny Nau. Should Stacy Parks Miller not prosecute Denny Nau, I will ask the court to appoint a competent attorney to prosecute her, 16 P.S. § 1406. Bernard Cantorna, whom recently announced his candidacy for District Attorney, is who I would like to have prosecuting both Denny Nau and Stacy Parks Miller, so that we might best evaluate his qualifications as the future Centre County District Attorney.

The greatest hotbed of criminal activity in Centre County is found on one block between East and West High streets in downtown Bellefonte, on a hill. I am in jail because I am being retaliated against for trying to operate as a one-man army, in the attempt to curb institutional and organized crime. You are not in jail, and so I would ask you write, call, and visit the District Attorney’s Office, at 102 S. Allegheny St., Centre County Courthouse, Room 404, Bellefonte, Pa. 16823, 814-355-6735.
