ORDER

AND NOW, this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2009 after hearing on the Commonwealth's Motion in Limine the court finds as follows:

1. Defendant is a resident of Centre County in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
2. Defendant possessed a license to carry a firearm issued by the Centre County Sheriff's Department on January 19, 2007.
3. On April 16, 2008, a letter advising Defendant his permit was going to be revoked effective April 14, 2008 was sent.
4. Defendant signed for the letter on April 29, 2008, and he turned his license over to the Centre County Sheriff's Office on May 2, 2008.
5. Under the 18 Pa.C.S.A. §6109, a resident of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania seeking a license to carry a firearm must apply to the sheriff of the county in which he resides.
6. Based on the statute, the court determines the defendant did not possess a valid license to carry a firearm on September 2, 2008.

The Commonwealth's Motion in Limine is accordingly GRANTED. Defendant is precluded from offering as a defense at trial the possession of any other license to carry firearm from any other state.
